Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the Maryland Cannabis Administration (MCA), is providing clarification regarding cannabis products available for retail sale.

Correction update: Effective June 7, 2024, MCA has released permanent regulations under <u>COMAR 14.17</u> that make certain changes for all licensees. Changes to products available for retail sale are highlighted below. Concentrates may now be sold for adult-use consumers as well as medical patients and caregivers.
