<b>Reason:</b> To notify dispensaries of changes to the Tribal Medical Patient sales process.		

Greetings,

Metrc, in conjunction with the Minnesota Office of Cannabis Management, would like to notify licensees of changes to the way that sales should be recorded for Tribal Medical Program patients.

Please read on for more information.

## Recording Sales for Tribal Medical Program Patients

To record a sale from a Tribal Medical Program patient, a dispensary agent will select the “External Patient” sales type as normal – see **Figure 1**.

**Figure 1: External Patient Customer Type**

Previously, the driver’s license number was recorded within the external patient fields. Under this new guidance, the dispensary agent will enter the Tribal Medical Program patient’s patient ID number into the “Patient No” field instead.

Within the “Patient No.” field, please use the format “TRIBAL PATIENT ID NUMBER-TRIBAL ABBR,” such as the below:

- White Earth Nation: “012345678–WEN”
- Red Lake Nation: “012345678–RLN”

Please note that there should be no spaces within the “Patient No.” field and that the “Ident. Method” field is required so “Minnesota” should be entered.

### Full List of Tribal Abbreviations

While not all Tribal Nations currently have a medical cannabis program, the OCM wanted to be sure that all users have a full list of abbreviations for all Tribes, should more implement medical cannabis programs in the future.

- Fond du Lac Reservation - FDL
- Gichi-Onigaming/Grand Portage Band of Lake Superior Chippewa - GPB
- Leech Lake Band of Ojibwe - LLB

- Prairie Island Indian Community - PII
- Red Lake Nation - RLN
- Shakopee Mdewakanton Sioux (Dakota) Community - SMS
- Upper Sioux Community - USC
