Greetings,

Metrc and the Mississippi Department of Health (MSDH) are pleased to provide the addition of a new Transdermal Patches Item Category.

Please read on for more detailed information.



Transdermal Patches

A new Transdermal Patch Item Category has been created for the permitted medical marijuana manufacturers that would like to begin producing Transdermal Patches. Transdermal patches are only available for registered patients and will deduct from a patient's allotment.

To use the Transdermal Patch Item Category, a new Item will need to be created. To create an Item, access the Admin area on the navigational toolbar and select the Items option from the dropdown – **see Figure 1**.

Once on the Items Grid, select the "Add Items" button to begin the process of creating an Item – **see Figure 2.**

This will open the Add Items action window. **The name of the new item being created must include the total mg of the item.** In the Category dropdown, select the Transdermal Patches option. Once all information has been entered and verified as accurate, select the Create Items button to create the item – **see Figure 3**.
